You will receive one bonus point in each of these areas in which there are no mistakes noted, and **FIVE BONUS POINTS FOR SUBMITTING THE REQUESTED COPIES OF THE FACT SHEET IN ITS FINAL FORM BY THE STATED DEADLINE.**

*If a parent is **deceased**, then here is an example of how you may appropriately list your parents' names: "Sue Smith and the late Joe Smith"*
